Provided that if the licensing authority is satisfied that the license exhibiting cinematography exhibitions is under loss, the licensing authority may reduce the seating capacity fixed in B Form License on an application made by a licensee subject to conditions prescribed in the rules.</p>

Cinema (Regulation, Rules 1970.</p> <p>➤ (a) Every application for renewal of a licence shall be made ninety days before the expiry of licence sought to be renewed and it shall be made in Form A-11 in triplicate accompanied by the treasury receipt for the payment of fees prescribed in Rule 16.</p> <p>➤ Certified or Xerox copies of the certificate of longevity of the building Issued by the Executive Engineer (R & B)</p> <p>➤ Certificate of validity of the Electrical</p> <p>➤ Certificate of Validity of Fire certificate</p> <p>➤ Treasury receipt/Challan</p>
